

YORGOS (Georgios) TAXIARCHOPOULOS

Born in Athens, Greece, on February 1972. Since 2018 he lives and works as freelancer art expert, artist and educator in Nicosia and Limassol. Currently he is appointed as the Director of the Limassol Municipality Art Center – Apothikes Papadaki in Cyprus, a part time job position. He was holding since September 2022 the position of the President of EUNIC cluster Cyprus for one year and since 2020 he was serving as Cultural Ambassador & General Director at the Hellenic Foundation for Culture in Cyprus. He has lived more than 10 years total abroad: in Sydney - Australia(1989-1992), Paris - France(2001-2003), Kitakyushu and Tokyo – Japan(2007-2008), Nicosia – Cyprus(2018-now). Some selected activities of his are: he served more than 12 years as freelancer organizer, general director, director of operations, production director, art logistics and insurance manager and art consultant at the largest international art events and exhibitions in Greece, Art-Athina, Art-Thessaloniki and the Hellenic Chamber of Greek Artists (EETE). He represented the Greek National Exhibition Organization, TIF-Helexpo, in private competitions about the Art Fairs of Athens and Thessaloniki. During his duty, he reduced 99,99% all risks, accidents, mysterious disappearances, losses and damages of art works and he had reset the amounts of reimbursements to exhibitors, artists and sponsors by the organizers of the Greek Art Fairs in Athens & Thessaloniki. Furthermore, among his duties was the design and implementation of the organizer's business plans and strategies, as well as the submissions of proposals for EU funding, private sponsoring and EU programs management. He was authorized to implement strategy for the organizations marketing, digital marketing, human resources, audience development, community building activities and art & cultural education parallel events. He was also developing policies about the business identity of the organizations, their rebranding, created organograms, overseen research & development, introducing new services & products, plus supervising their accounting departments, created budgets, communication policies concerning the audience and the mass media relations as well as the cultural advertisement campaigns and crowdfunding campaigns.
